

Dear Wheatland Township Residents:

Since 2013, Wheatland Township has negotiated a fixed price electricity supply contract for our residents and small businesses. The goal of this program has been to provide electricity cost savings compared to purchasing your electrical supply from ComEd and has worked successfully.

ComEd's electricity supply price is set once a year to reflect summer and non-summer pricing and the new rates are Summer Months (June-September 2016) \$0.06195 per kWh and October 2016-May 2017 will be \$0.06300 per kWh. These rates, for the first time, will be below our current fixed price contract with Constellation Energy of \$0.07568 per kWh. This means the average customer this year will see an approximate \$14.00 per month in electricity supply costs over and above the comparable ComEd supply rate.

The Township negotiated the agreement with Constellation so that at any time, you have a choice to return to ComEd for your electricity supply without any cost to you. Depending on when you notify ComEd of your desire to return to utility supply, the switch-over will occur effective your next meter read date. This could take 4-6 weeks. If you elect to return to ComEd utility supply, you could later elect to join in the Townships program if and when we negotiate the next rate, assuming we achieve one better than ComEd's default rate. This would not be in effect until May 2017.

If you choose to return to ComEd utility supply, please have your account number ready and call ComEd at 1-800-EDISON-1 and let them know that you would like to return to utility service at the earliest date available.
