

Resignation Letter August <sup>24</sup>~~23~~, 2021

This letter is serving notice that I am resigning my position as the elected "Tax Collector" (Cemetery Manager) effective at next Township Meeting, Sept. 9<sup>th</sup>, upon conclusion of my August Report.

This Notice should allow reasonable time for Township Management to ascertain whether David Scriven-Young, the recently elected successor, is willing, as is my understanding, to be installed as my immediate replacement.

If so, I suggest that the Sept. 9<sup>th</sup> Township Agenda includes reference to accepting my resignation and voting to install as interim replacement, David Scriven-Young. The Clerk should be prepared to read the Oath and initiate notifications to Will County and other agencies for newly installed officials.
